The Knights of Columbus St. Joseph the Carpenter Council Scholarship, was established in 2008 through the generous support of the Green Estate.

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide support for higher education and to encourage students to embrace their Catholic Faith. It is intended for parishioners of St. Joseph Catholic Church who are high school seniors intending to further their education beyond high school, be it university, vocational/trade school, or continuing education classes.

Individually, four \$500 scholarships will be awarded in 2018 to recognize worthy parishioners who demonstrate their Catholic Faith through active participation in:

- St Joseph's Parish worship
- St Joseph's Parish youth ministry
- Community activities
- Academic scholarship and activities

The Scholarship Selection Committee will use the following criteria to determine the scholarship recipients.

1. St Joseph's Parish Worship
Examples: Attendance and active participation in Masses, lay ministry work at Mass, adoration, and other forms of parish sponsored worship.
2. St Joseph's Parish Youth Ministry
Examples: Attendance and active participation in Life Teen events and classes, attendance at conferences, gatherings, and retreats, service projects, and fundraisers and other youth ministry sponsored events.
3. Community & School Activities
Examples: FCA, Right to Life and volunteer work and other activities that enhance your Catholic Faith.
4. Higher education plans after high school.

- Completed application, with school certification.
- Letter(s) of reference from a lay minister or parish member from St. Joseph's, Lebanon, who are not related.

 2. How have you participated in St Joseph's Parish Youth Ministry? Include activities and frequency.
